Examination date Uttar Pradesh NTSE 2019 – 2020 for Class X Stage 1 & 2 has been announced, candidates can refer to the table given below. NTSE stage 1 is usually conducted by the state board for class 10th students. Those students who qualify stage 1 of NTSE are eligible to appear in National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) stage II to be conducted by NCERT, New Delhi.

Eligibility Criteria

All students of Class X studying in recognized schools are eligible to appear for the Stage I examination, conducted by the State/ UTs in which the schools are located. There will be no domicile restriction.

Students registered under Open Distance Learning (ODL) will also be eligible for scholarship, provided the student is below the age of 18 years (as on 1st July of the particular year), the student is not employed and she/he is appearing in class X examination for the first time. Examination Scheme.

The exam pattern is as below:

Stage I & II: Examination at the State/UT level will comprise two papers i.e
